- Grand and Reserve Champion awards are given to the **horse/rider combination** earning the highest total points in the following divisions: Suitability for Dressage, Working Western, Western Pleasure, Huntseat, Field Hunter, Over Fences
- Although ribbons may not be given for all places through 10th, points will be accumulated according to the chart above, following the 4-H Horse Program national standard.
- Trail, Showmanship and Halter each have their own special awards. Their points ARE NOT included in the high point awards.

Tie Breaker Rules:

- Highest number of points in equitation classes.
- Greatest number of placings that earned points towards champion and reserve.
- Number of first place ribbons.

Year End High Point Awards

- At the December show the points from each show will be tallied for horse/rider combos.
- There are no circuit nominations or fees required. Only one show is required for awards.
- Participation in the circuit is automatic. Everyone is eligible.
- The horse and rider must use the exact same name spelling at both shows in order for points to add correctly. Please let the points secretary in the office know of any changes.
- It is the responsibility of the exhibitor to verify that their information is correct in our standings. This is especially important if you show at both shows. The standings will be posted Saturday night and all exhibitors should verify that their points have carried over correctly. Any issues detected should be addressed ASAP Sunday morning. No changes will be made to posted information after noon on Sunday.
